PLAYER OF THE WEEK -- Salve Regina University graduate student midfielder **Alex Clark** (Ridgefield, Conn.) led the Seahawks to an impressive 4-0 week, including three TCCC victories. Clark contributed at least one point in all four of his teams matches this week. His best performance came against Endicott, where Clark netted the game-winner and added an assist in a 3-1 win. ROOKIE OF THE WEEK -- Salve Regina University freshman midfielder **Tony Lania** (Newburyport, Mass.) secured a huge road TCCC victory against the University of New England in dramatic fashion, heading home the game-winner in the 106th minute to give the Seahawks a 2-1 double overtime win. Lania scored three goals on the week, as he opened the scoring against Regis in a 8-0 win, and netted the third goal in a 3-1 victory at Endicott.
