Dynamic duo powers C-C

LOWELL - Concord-Carlisle made the most improbable comeback in the Division 2 North playoff bracket when it rallied from three goals down against Masconomet in the semifinals to win, 4-3.

Yesterday, the top-ranked Patriots looked like a No. 1 seed from the start and handed Dracut a 3-1 loss in the final at Cawley Stadium.

Michael Burke, who scored all three second-half goals in the comeback vs. Masconomet, continued his strong play with a goal and an assist. Theo Terris also had a goal and an assist, and Tony Lania added a third goal for the Patriots, who will play Sharon tomorrow for the EMass title.

Burke and Terris dominated, putting pressure on the Dracut defense until it caved. The forwards work well together, and both will play soccer at George Washington University next year.

"I don't think there's a better duo in the state anywhere," Patriots coach Ray Pavlik said.

Burke began the scoring in the 15th minute after a scuffle in front of the Dracut goal left the defense vulnerable. Keeper Stephen Diamantopoulos tried to smother the ball on the right side of the box, but it popped loose to his left and Burke sent it into the lower right corner of the net.

Terris threatened during the first half and finally scored near the 39-minute mark.

A few minutes earlier, Terris put topspin on a shot from about 20 yards but the dipping ball glanced off the top of the crossbar.

Then Burke fed Terris about 20 yards from the Dracut net on the left side of the box. Terris dribbled to his left, freed up his left leg, and drilled a low liner past the diving keeper into the bottom right corner.

The Patriots added a third goal 22 minutes into the second half. Concord-Carlisle had a numerical advantage on a break. Terris dribbled up the middle of the field and drew a defender to him, leaving Lania wide open down the left sideline. Terris hit him in stride and Lania kicked it by the charging keeper.

Kyle Adie scored for Dracut off a corner kick with about 4:30 left in the game. ■
